On behalf of Emmy Lamers and Jelle Scheurleer I am sending you an update of information on the hands-on course Intensity-Modulated Radiation Therapy Treatment Planning (IMRT TP) that will be organised by INHolland University of Applied Sciences in Haarlem, The Netherlands in November this year.

This international IMRT TP hands-on course will take place from Monday 02-NOV-09 to Friday 06-NOV-09 and will be given in English. On Sunday 01-NOV-09 an introductory session is organised. The course is designed for radiation therapy technologists (RTTs), medical physicists/radiation oncologists (in training) and medical engineers working in RT departments.

RTTs, physicists or engineers working for companies that develop RT products may also benefit from this course.

The emphasis is on the practical aspects of IMRT TP; i.e. this course should be considered as a complement to more general courses on this topic. It is primarily meant for persons who will be actively involved in the treatment planning of IMRT and want to know more about the various approaches for specific cases, as well as the possibilities of modern treatment planning systems to plan these cases.
